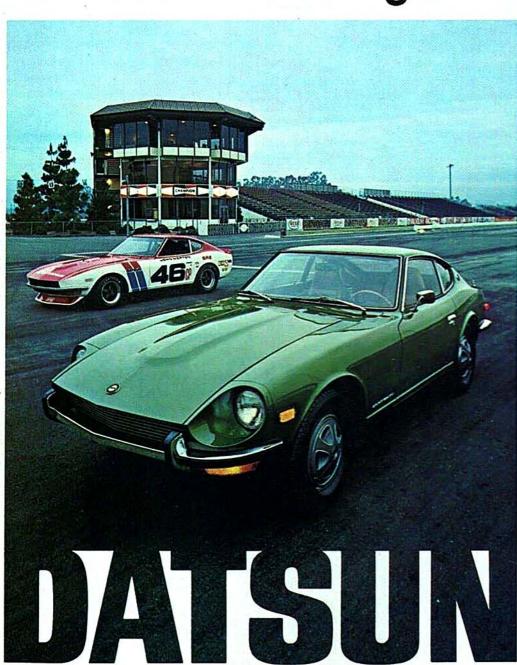
The Datsun 240-Z on the left is no ordinary GT.
